The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting an Industry Forum for the reconstruction of Tampa's Westshore Interchange (I-275/SR 60) in Hillsborough County, FL. The Industry Forum provides an opportunity for Design-Build teams, including contractors, subcontractors, and design consultants, to learn more about the project and the delivery method.

Attendance (in-person or virtually) is not mandatory but is recommended to firms considering roles on the project. Following the presentation, time will be allotted for questions from participants.

One-on-One Meetings: Following the Industry Forum, Design-Build teams are invited to meet one-on-one with Tampa's Westshore Interchange (I-275/SR 60) project Technical Review Committee (TRC) members and with Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) Support Services Program representatives from the Equal Employment Opportunity Office. The one-on-one meetings will be held following the presentation on September 1, 2022. These meetings will be in-person only and be held at Port Tampa Bay Terminal 2.
