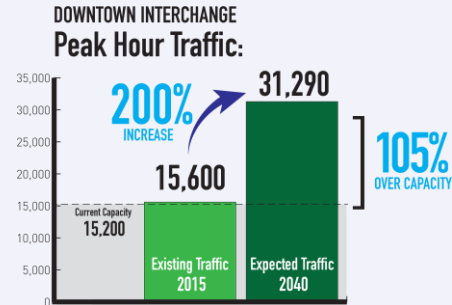

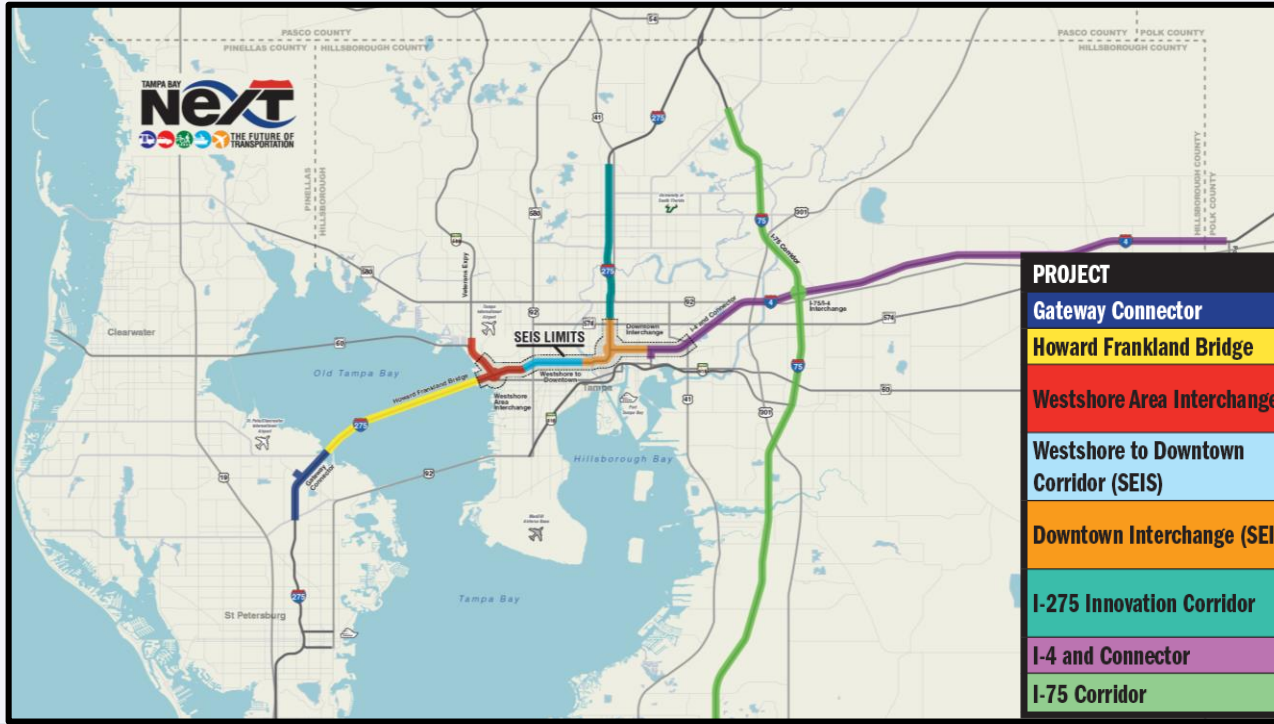

Gateway Expressway

The **Gateway Expressway project** will create two new 4-lane elevated tolled roadways that will provide express connections from US 19 to I-275 and from the Bayside Bridge (north of 49th Street N) to I-275. A segment of tolled express lanes along I-275 from south of Gandy Boulevard to 4th Street North will also be constructed with this project.

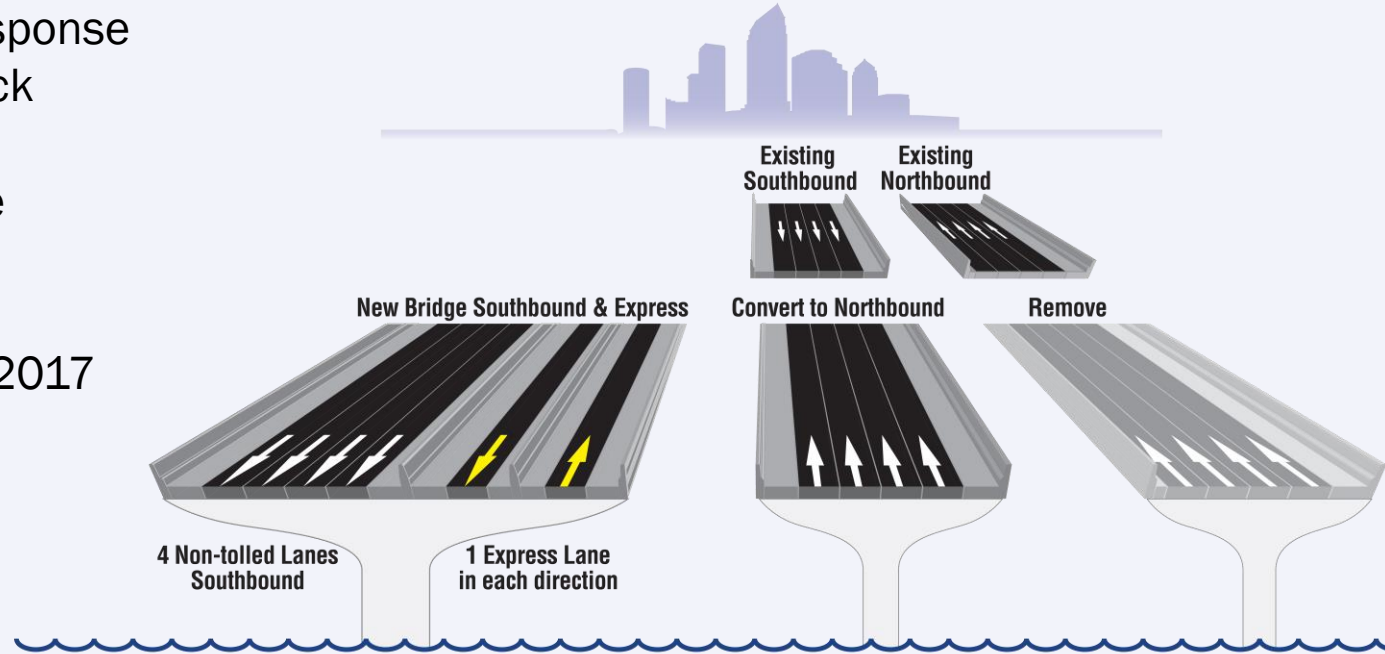
Anticipated construction start: January 2018

- Anticipated Begin Construction – 2020



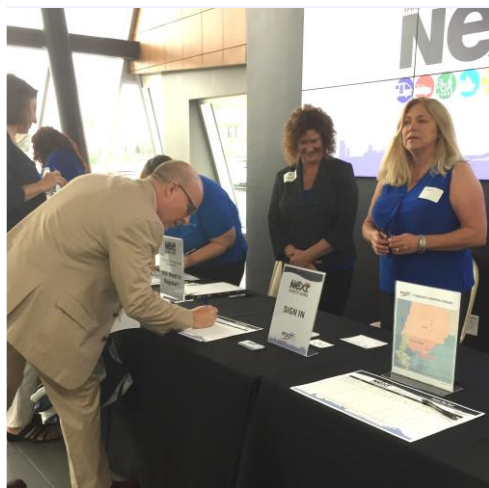
