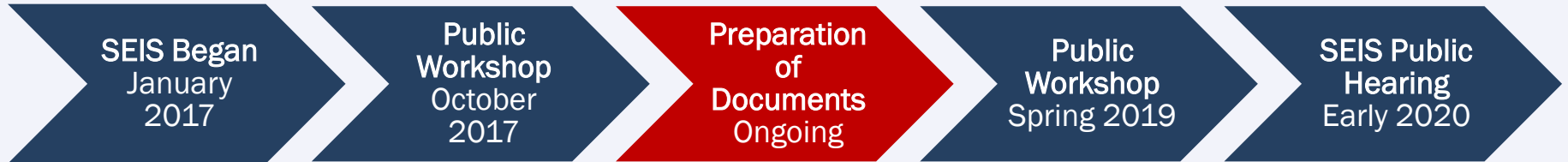

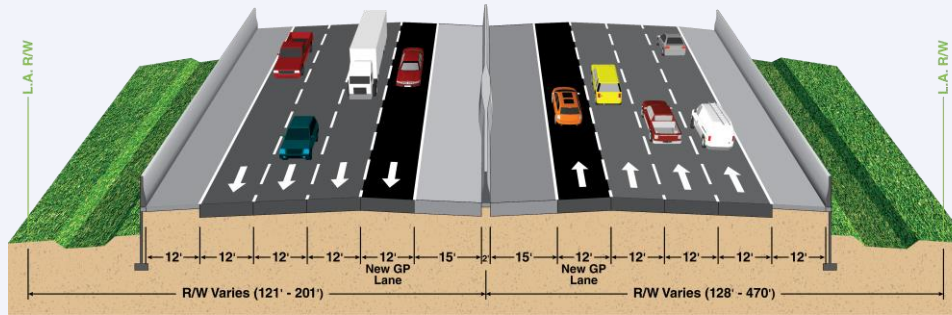
ALL documents remain in DRAFT form and open for public comment until after the Public Hearing in 2020.



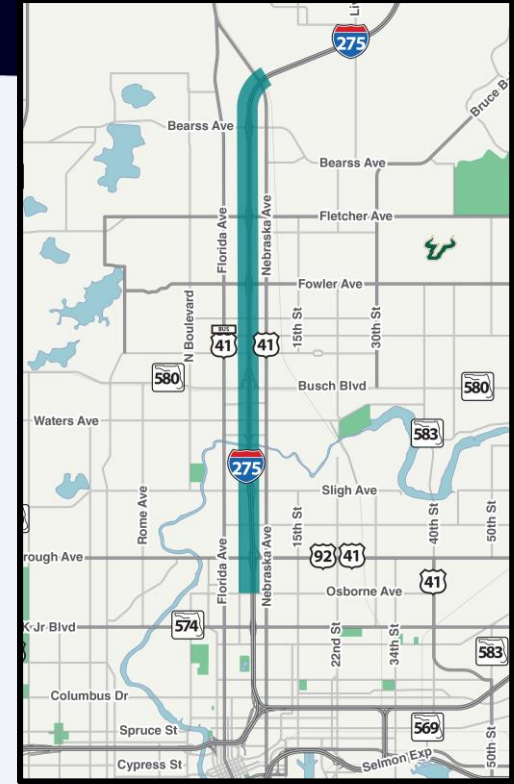
\*A Preferred Alternative will be recommended after the Spring 2019 Public Workshop.

# I-275 North Corridor

- Adding one lane in each direction **within the existing Right of Way**
- Wide shoulder for transit\*
- Interchange improvements along corridor
- Bike/Ped safety enhancements at interchanges
- Aesthetics and noise walls



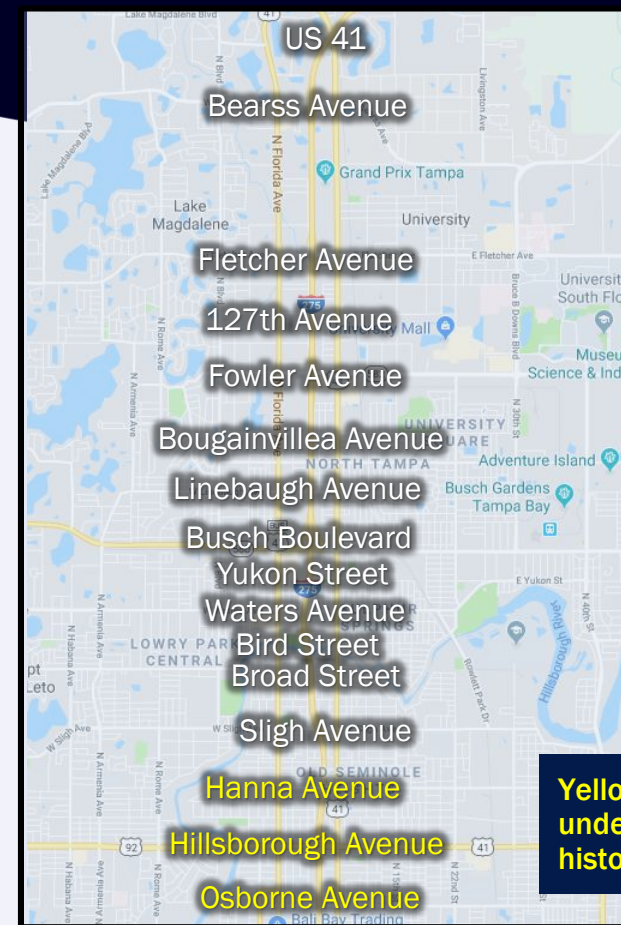

# Pedestrian Friendly Underpass Improvements

- Widen Sidewalks
- Enhance Lighting
- Paint Bridge Sub-Structure
- Cut-back Walls for Improved Bike/Pedestrian Experience
- Include Public Art (in cooperation with City of Tampa)
- Identify Landscape Opportunities

*Listed improvements are yet finalized for each underpass.  
All improvements will not be included at every underpass.*

- Future coordination with affected property owners and local government to take place during the next project phase
